"I knew exactly what I was doing," says Fantasia Barrino, who will be on a "Behind the Music" special Tuesday.

Fantasia's overdose was no accident

Fantasia Barrino said she "wanted it all to be over."

In a "Behind the Music" special airing Tuesday on VH1, the former "American Idol" winner said she intentionally overdosed on aspirin and a sleep aid. The special will air the same day her new album, "Back to Me," comes out.

"I just sat in the closet and looked at the mirror and took all the pills in the bottle," Barrino said, according to People.com. "I wanted to go to sleep and just be at peace. I knew exactly what I was doing. You can't accidentally take a whole bottle of pills."

The singer said she was, "tired of people doing (her) wrong."

Besides dealing with the fallout over her attempted suicide, Barrino has been threatened with a lawsuit from Paula Cook, the estranged wife of Antwaun Cook, the man Barrino has been dating. Barrino's overdose came shortly after news of court filings by Paula Cook that alleged, among other things, that Barrino and Antwaun Cook made a sex tape.

"When I met him, he wasn't living in his home," Barrino said of Antwaun Cook. "He didn't want to be back with his wife — this is what I was told."
