

Davis says Barrino show will proceed

Fantasia Barrino's performance next weekend at A.J. Simeon Stadium will go ahead according to Guilford County Commissioner Bruce Davis.

Management for the High Point native and American Idol winner has agreed to send the singer to two performances during a High Point AIDS Coalition benefit concert scheduled for Saturday at A.J. Simeon Stadium.

Davis is a member of the

coalition and also of the group Friends of Fantasia, which helped pay for the singer's family to attend her appearances on "American Idol 3."

Davis said he spent Friday morning planning a homecoming event for the singer with local agencies. He added that the group is still working on obtaining funding for the event, which is expected to cost up to \$10,000.

Davis said Thursday he is not considering charging for tickets to the event, which he expects thousands would attend.
